The Community Memorial Hall was constructed by Orwigsburg Community Memorial, Inc. and dedicated in July 1950 as a tribute to veterans of the Orwigsburg Area.

A subsequent project included the addition of a kitchen, ticket booth and lobby and the installation of a brick facade over the block walls.

The interior of the building includes a large open area with seating capacity for more than 1,500 on permanent and retractable bleacher with a basketball court, locker rooms and restrooms.

The Memorial is the anchor to an overall community recreation area that includes multiple baseball fields; a playground and an outdoor basketball/tennis court area.
